

Finalizing the Implementation Plan for Phase I of Measure H

The Facilities and Construction Committee continued their work on the Measure H implementation plan this month. With the final priorities set, bond sale options reviewed, and fund plans developed the team will be reviewing the plan for Phase I with the Board of Trustees at the March 9, 2023, Board Meeting.

The plan will reflect the different opinions within the community based on the multiple touchpoints the team had with different Measure H stakeholders. Additionally, it will show the budget and different options for spending the first Phase of measure H. Finally, it will identify funding sources for all the projects and identify unfunded projects that potentially could be included in Phase I should additional funding become available.

The plan will also show the potential projects for Phase II of the Measure H bond Program and a potential timetable for those projects based on the availability of additional bond sales.

<u>Citizens Bond Oversight</u> <u>Committee Members</u> <u>Needed</u>

In November 2000, the voters of the State of California approved an amendment of the California Constitution (Proposition 39) lowering the voter approval requirement from 2/3rds to 55% for school districts that provide voters a specific list of projects, a committee of appointed citizens to oversee the expenditure of funds and an annual performance audit and financial audit of the bond funds and bond projects. In addition, Proposition 39 provides that the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee shall have at least seven (7) members who shall serve up to two (2) terms of two (2) years each.

Measure H was passed in compliance with Proposition 39, and the Hillsborough City School District is establishing a Citizens Bond Oversight Committee for this bond measure. If you are interested in serving on the committee, there are open seats; please contact the district office for an application.
