# Crocker Middle School Projects & More

Waterline Relocation, Roofing and HVAC, and Culinary Arts



## **Crocker staff welcomed students to Camp Crocker for the First Day of School!**

**Roofing and HVAC:** All buildings at Crocker now has a new roof and HVAC system installed throughout the campus with the exception of the current MPR which will be demolished Summer 2026 for the New MPR project.

**Culinary Arts:** Phase I is now complete! Contractors worked on removing previously fixed items such as cabinets, work stations, and flooring. They added new drywall and paint, providing a new brighter Culinary Arts Space. New electrical outlets, new sinks with hot water, new refrigerator and new furnishings have also been added to the space! Phase II will commence in Summer 2026, which includes adding storage, relocating the sink and new casework, floor installation, and adding additional furnishings to complete the dining room.

**District Wide Security Upgrades:** All cameras are up and running for all sites including the district office! First responders will have access to ActiveNet to assist in case of emergencies.

**Town of Hillsborough Waterline Relocation:** Contractors worked throughout the summer to quickly relocate a waterline that went through the Crocker campus. The project required for the contractors to shut down the water but all is well and the project is near completion.
