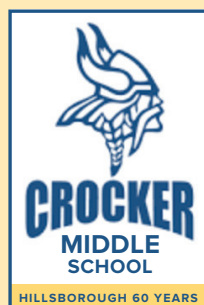


We prepare our students to see themselves as part of an interconnected and interdependent world, invested in making a positive impact on their family, community and beyond.

Our confidence-building environment prepares our students well to advance to excellent public and private high schools.

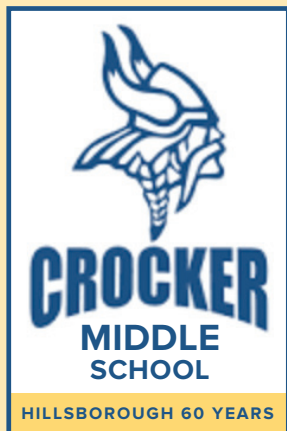
