<u>Citizens Bond Oversight</u> <u>Committee Members Needed</u>

In November 2000, the voters of the State of California approved an amendment of the California Constitution (Proposition 39) lowering the voter approval requirement from 2/3rds to 55% for school districts that provide voters a specific list of projects, a committee of appointed citizens to oversee the expenditure of funds and an annual performance audit and financial audit of the bond funds and bond projects. In addition, Proposition 39 provides that the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee shall have at least seven (7) members who shall serve up to two (2) terms of two (2) years each.

Measure H was passed in compliance with Proposition 39, and the Hillsborough City School District is establishing a Citizens Bond Oversight Committee for this bond measure. New Colors!

The potential color palette for South School was on display for review and comments, and it had a great turn out on feedback. Most responses, at over 60%, favored the Wood Ash Body, Fiery Opal Doors, and Great Plains Gold Columns. This feedback will now go to the design team to finalize the new color palette for South School. A new addition to the exterior painting project is North School, and a potential color palette is in the works, and will be displayed at the at the main office for the community's feedback.

A Pod Remodel

At South, carpet in all the classrooms, hallways, and library has been of service for over 25 years and has held up great considering its age. Now it is time to give the campus a refresh. The Facilities and Construction team, including Maintenance and Operations representatives, is currently in the process of selecting new flooring material, style, and colors for South. Material selections have been made. The color selections are in progress, and we plan on installing in Summer of 2023.

Classroom Technology

Interactive display panels offer numerous benefits that can enhance learning and collaboration. One of the main advantages of interactive displays is their ability to increase engagement. The Technology, Facilities, and Construction team is working together to select the high-tech panels and create a plan to deploy them to every classroom at Hillsborough City School District. The team has completed its selection of Smart Boards and is finalizing the ancillary equipment required for the operation of the Smart Boards. Facilities and Construction team is utilizing piggy-back purchasing methods to expedite the purchase of the boards.

<u>Solar</u>

The Facilities and Construction team has submitted the interconnection permit for a potential Solar Project as a part of Measure H. By submitting the interconnection permit in a timely manner, the team has ensured the District will receive NEM 2.0 pricing for its power generation should it move forward with the solar project. The team continues its work on the ROI evaluation for this project and plan on reviewing it with the Board of Trustees prior to the summer break.
