Crocker MPR, West MPR, Roofing/HVAC and Underground Line Replacements

Crocker Field Upgrade

The Facilities and Construction team continues its work on the Crocker Field project. The Board of Trustees has approved the contract with Verde Desing for the architectural services on this project. Additionally, the topographic and underground survey will take place in October to help determine the placement of the field's design elements. Finally, the geotechnical hazards report will begin in October and take 4-6 weeks to complete. While these preliminary reports are underway, the team is forming design committees to meet with the architect to develop the project's design.

New MPRs

Design

Both of the new MPRs geotechnical reports and surveys are underway in October. The Facilities and Construction team hosted meetings at both sites to get initial input from the users and students on the design of the MPRs. Additional sessions for community input will be held virtually and in person in the month of October. Finally, the Bond team is bringing its work on RFPs to select the contractors for both projects.

Misc. Other Projects

West Underground Utility Lines, UPS Upgrades, and New Marquee Signs

The Facilities and Construction team continued its work on several other smaller but equally important projects in Measure H. The first of those is the underground utility replacement for West School. This critical infrastructure project will replace aging and failing utilities on the West Campus. The design team has been finalizing the design over the past two months. The team anticipates bidding on these projects in December for Construction over the summer of 2024. The Facilities team coordinates closely with Maintenance on these projects to ensure the end product is acceptable.

The final proposal for the new Marquee signs is going to the Board of Trustees for approval in October. These signs will match the City of Hillsborough marquee signs and provide a much-needed digital solution for the sites to communicate on-site to the community.

As part of the classroom technology projects for the Bond, the District is replacing its UPS systems with network technology. These new systems will provide critical power backup for each site to keep the network functioning and allow it to safely be powered down despite power failures. The UPSs have already been purchased and are expected to arrive this month and be installed by the end of the year.
