



\*DO NOT use "passing lane" during morning drop off

### General Information:

- \*2 lanes enter onto the blacktop:
  - LEFT LANE (orange line) filters into LANES 1 or 2
  - RIGHT LANE (green line) filters into LANES 3 or 4

**\* CARS ARE NEVER ALLOWED IN THE CENTER STUDENT AREA.**

**\* ALWAYS WATCH FOR STUDENTS CROSSING!**

### Morning Drop off Procedure:

- \* After student exits car, he/she walks directly towards the center student area. DO NOT walk between car lanes.
- \* As your student walks away, please drive forward to the RED LINE painted on the pavement and exit, or as directed by school staff for Lanes 3 & 4.
- \* DO NOT use the "passing lane" during morning drop off.

### Afternoon Drop Off Procedure:

- \* Drive into the "waiting area" of your designated lane -> move forward as the car in front of you moves. The first car of each lane should pull up to the RED LINE painted on the pavement.
- \* LANE 1 does not have a passing lane. When ready to leave, you should safely turn out of the lane to merge with other cars that are exiting the blacktop.
- \* LANES 2, 3, 4 - when ready to leave, merge into the "passing lane" and drive forward to exit (school staff will direct you on Lanes 3 & 4).
- \* DO NOT wait for your student while in the "passing lane."
